

# I CAN'T... Do This on My Own

**CES Annual Report 20** 

With morning sickness beginning and a home pregnancy test showing positive, Alexis was pretty sure she was pregnant. After driving by CHOICES several times, and seeing our sign out front, Alexis knew she could get a free pregnancy test. Alexis' worst fears were confirmed when the test came back positive. Her one-year relationship with her boyfriend had just ended badly and she was staying with a friend. It was June of 2018.

Alexis left CHOICES that day uncertain of what to do with her pregnancy as she felt she 'couldn't do this on her own'. Our client advocate had spoken with her

whole way supporting her. Yet Alexis left still undecided.

Despite many attempts to follow up with Alexis to schedule that ultrasound, she disappeared, and we were unable to reconnect with her to know what she had decided.

Fast forward to October 2018 and Alexis came in to have her WIC form signed and inquire about EWYL classes. She had made an older and more mature friend in Nora who was eager to go through the parenting classes with Alexis. At 27 weeks, Alexis would begin to earn baby bucks

for attending parenting classes. Earning baby bucks gives her access to our baby boutique for shopping trips! She has been so excited to be able to get everything she needs for her baby.

### What has CHOICES been up to in 2018?

We have served **262** individual clients – 225 women and 37 men

Of those 262 clients **121** were brand new to CHOICES, **141** were returning clients who are already connected to one of our programs.

We had a total of **1919** client visits, some of those visit highlights are:

### 104 - Pregnancy Tests

The true measure of our success in meeting the heart of our mission, with 11 truly being abortion minded and 59 abortion vulnerable with the remainder "likely to carry". Of the 104 tests, 49 (nearly half) were positive.

Of those 49, 13 are currently connected to a mentor and are completing EWYL classes.

### • **29** – Ultrasounds

20 standard diagnostic ultrasounds and 9 training ultrasounds. Of those 4 were abortion minded/undecided and 11 were abortion vulnerable. Average age was 26.7.

### 47 - STI Appointments

17 new STI clients, 3 repeat clients. 15 were female and 5 males, Average age of clients 23.

- **902** Earn While You Learn (EWYL) parenting classes As of 12-31-18 we had 19 mentors seeing 49 clients (this includes 14 client couples)
- 21 Certified Car Seat Checks
- 428 Shoppers in our Baby Boutique

While most clients shop at the same time as their class, these clients came in solely to shop. Some of their "Baby Bucks" were earned from one of our partner agencies. (Community Partnership, TRE, Early Headstart, Nurse Family Partnership, TESSA, Pitt Stop Counseling LLC, and other Teller County agencies.)


## We certainly couldn't carry out the mission of CHOICES without all of our volunteers.

 36 Volunteers served over 2120 hours working in the CHOICES offices. Our mentors served over 480 hours, and the Baby Boutique volunteers 708 hours. We had an additional 23 volunteers who put in *countless* hours designing and creating items for the Rocky Mountain Christmas Boutique.
