Do you remember Alyssa and her children, Link, Tillie, and Vanellope, from pages 2-3 of the 2022 CHOICES Baby Calendar? We spoke more in-depth with Alyssa recently to help share the progression of her life from 2015 to 2022 with CHOICES as one of her support systems.

On June 16, 2015, Alyssa, a pregnant, 24-year-old young woman, arrived in Colorado from Georgia to begin a new life with her boyfriend. She had no friends or family in Cripple Creek. Thankfully, she was directed to CHOICES and there began a 7-year relationship. It would be some time before she had any family in the area, and I think it is safe to say, CHOICES mentors became her family.

With her first baby, Link, Alyssa joined CHOICES' *Earn While You Learn* Parenting Program (weekly meetings with a parent mentor) and was able to earn baby bucks along the way to help supply her with everything needed for her baby. She was excited and committed to the program and made great strides. Link was featured in the 2017 CHOICES Baby Calendar as Mr. April! Alyssa did everything she could to get to classes – she was determined to learn and become the mom she desired to be.

In September 2016, along came Matilda Lee Clementine (Tilly). Since Alyssa was already in the EWYL Parenting Program with Link, she and her mentor were able to go back to refresher lessons on pregnancy and labor and delivery, in conjunction with the early childhood development classes to help her parent Link. Alyssa understood the power of connection with her mentor and the benefit of the program to help supply her with the items she needed for her kids. She was grateful for help in navigating the ups and downs of adding a second child to the family, locating resources she needed, and for fresh emotional support as she navigated the end of the relationship with the father of these two children.

In 2021, when Alyssa discovered she was pregnant with baby number three, she immediately came to CHOICES because, she said, "They know what to do and how to help me." She and her new fiancé have consistently attended classes and are learning and growing as a couple and a family. Sweet Vanellope was born April 19, 2021, and is featured in the 2022 CHOICES Baby Calendar on the cover and as Miss July!


